

XIV. RULES OF CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOR ON LIBRARY PREMISES

- A. No animals are allowed inside the building except Assistance Animals.
- B. No political campaigning is allowed, except as scheduled use of the meeting room.
- C. No food or drink is allowed, except in the meeting room.
- D. No gambling is allowed, including computer gambling.
- E. No harassment of other patrons will be tolerated.
- F. No loitering, sleeping, loud or abusive language, playing of media without headphones, or other disturbing behavior is allowed.
- G. No public drunkenness is allowed on Library grounds.
- H. No sexual acts or sexual harassment is allowed.
- I. No soliciting is allowed.
- J. Children must be supervised by the accompanying adult, or as required by the librarian, or as permitted as a part of Story Hour, or at the discretion of the Librarian on duty. See Idaho Statute 16-1619: Abuse/Neglect/Abandonment of children.
- K. No weapons or dangerous objects are allowed.
- L. All patrons must comply with the Internet Policy.
- M. Any other behavior deemed to be inappropriate by library personnel.

The Library Director will determine whether a violation of any of these rules is to result in warning, or suspension or termination of library privileges.
